WHEREAS; BY SHARING THE EARLY WARNING SIGNS OF LUNG CANCER, THERE IS AN INCREASED CHANCE FOR EARLY DETECTION AND TREATMENT OF THE DISEASE BEFORE IT BECOMES LIFE THREATENING; AND NOW
